## MEDSTATS Information Considerations for First Responders and Hospitalization

- Patient information regarding medical history/illness, medications and allergies to medications. This should include past surgeries and joint replacements.
- Insurance information for transportation and/or admittance to the hospital.
- Medical directions or wishes: consents/power of medical authority/
  Pre-Hospital Medical Care Directive (Do Not Resuscitate) forms from the AZ Attorney General website <a href="https://www.azag.gov/seniors/life-care-planning">https://www.azag.gov/seniors/life-care-planning</a>
- Contact information of family members or friends/neighbors you wish to contact in case of emergency. Consider cell phones and chargers if you transported to the hospital.
- Instructions on how to secure your residence if you need to be transported to hospital.
- Instructions on how you would like pets secured or taken care of if you need transportation to hospital.
- Instructions for friends or neighbors for taking care of concerns if you need to be away from home for more than 24 hours.
- Consider contacting Local Fire Department non-emergency line to provide critical information that can be provided in an alert if have to call for Emergency Services.
